At the risk of his own life, assisted in carrying to a place of safety a wounded and helpless officer. 2nd. Medal of Honor, date of action Apr. 2, 1865. Peterburg. Va.

Advanced with the Pioneers and under heavy fire, assisted in removing two lines of Chevaux-de-fuse, was twice wounded but advanced to the third line, where he was again severely wounded, losing a leg.

Awarded Medal of honor November. 19, 1897
