

Invalid Army Pension.

On this 5th day of July A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty-five, personally appeared before me, Prothonotary of the District Court, in and for the said County and State, Charles H. Tracy aged 29 years, a resident of Springfield State of Massachusetts, who, being duly sworn, according to law, declares that he is the identical Charles H. Tracy who enlisted in the service of the United States at Chicopee Mass. on the 6th day of August, in the year 1862, as a Sergeant in company "C", commanded by 3rd regiment of Map. Vets., in the war of 1861, and was honorably discharged on the 4th day of July in the year 1865; that while in the service aforesaid, and in the line of his duty, he received a gun shot wound in the right leg in action at Petersburg Va. April 2^d 1865 - by reason of which the leg was amputated. Sent to Army Square U.S. Hosp. Washington April 12th 1865 - To U.S. Hosp. Chester Pa. on 1st the last of May 1865. (Occupation when enlisted Machinist)
